## **PART B**

### **1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution:**

The ultimate objective of the various activities planned under different forums like College Union, Sports, Placements, Visits to Industrial Units, Youth Festival, Ladies Association and Women's Empowerment Cell etc. is to help our students understand the curriculum properly, provide ample opportunities and exposure to their hidden talent, develop communication skills in them so that they groom their personality to suit the needs of the fast changing world.

#### ➤ **Teaching Plan :**

A 'Teaching Plan' in all the subjects was prepared at the beginning of the academic year. A 'Calendar of Events' containing a broad out-lay of various events spread out throughout the year was also prepared and published in the 'Prospectus' so that the students had a clear idea about them in advance. At the end of the year, a kind of stock taking was done in H.O.D.'s meeting whether all these activities were implemented or not.

#### ➤ **Activities of Union & Gymkhana :**

Various Associations and Gymkhana Departments which were formed at the beginning of the year with an objective of giving an exposure to the students hidden talent and caliber, were kept active through out the year. The Inaugural Function of these sections was held on 29th August 2006. Sri. Gopalkrishna Hegde, Chief of Bureau of Sports of Prajavani & Deccan Herald, was the Guest of Honour.

The college Athletic Meet was held on 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup> October 2006 in which a large number of students, both boys and girls, participated actively. The Annual Indoor Game Tournaments were held in January 2007 which also witnessed a very good participation from the students. Similarly, a good number of functions were organized inviting eminent academicians, businessmen, motivational speakers etc. with a view to enable the students to not only widen the horizon of their knowledge but also to develop their personality.

Valedictory function of College Union and Gymkhana activities was held on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2007. On 23<sup>rd</sup> the newly constructed "Golden Jubilee Gymkhana Hall" was inaugurated by our beloved Chairman Sri. Prabhakar Kore. The Guests of honour on the occasion were Sri.
