## **BEST PRACTICE I**

- 1. Title of the practice :** Mahamajjan-Cleaning of Statues of National Heroes in and around Hubballi-Dharwad on the eve of Karnataka Rajyotsava.
- 2. Objective of the practice:**

  - To inculcate respect for National Heroes and Values in the young minds.
  - Creating awareness regarding clean and green environment.

- 3. The Context:**

Students being concerned with their studies and career, it is incumbent on the teaching community to involve the students in the socially responsible activities and selfless service. It is our duty to pay homage and respect to the national heroes and follow their teachings in their desire to be the good citizens of the nation.
- 4. The Practice:**

A day prior to the National importance, our NSS volunteers enthusiastically march towards the statues of the National Heroes at public places across the city. The Institution provides resources required for the cleaning purpose such as Water tank and other materials. The NSS Volunteers along with Programme Officers will visit to Municipal Corporation Office and the Commissioner will provide help and assistance in the cleaning process by sparing labor.

The students voluntarily involved in the practice with great zeal and enthusiasm. On the eve of the said day of national importance. The Students along with NSS Programme Officers gather the necessary equipments and go to the targeted places. First the statues are dry cleaned with the cloth and later on cleaned with mild soapy water and wiped dry. On an average our volunteers clean 5-6 statues every time. The next day morning they will join the Municipal Authorities in the function organized, remember the teachings and great deeds of the National Heroes.

As the student who participate in the Mahamajjan activity miss the classes on that day, however, the concerned teachers will engage a special class for those who have participated in the above activity. The expenses incurred for the same event will be borne by the Institution.
