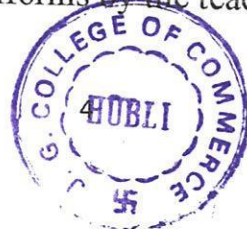

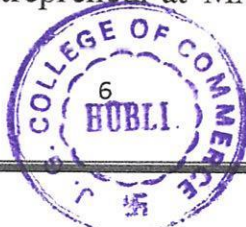

➤ **23rd September to 29th September 2022 - University level leadership training camp**

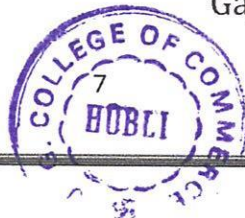

➤ **13TH October 2022 to 23rd October 2022 -Adventure camp 2022 at Narkanda Himachal Pradesh**

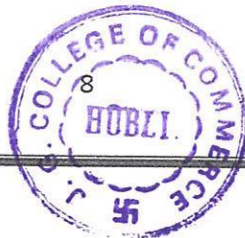

➤ **14th November 2022 -Celebration of Childrens Day**

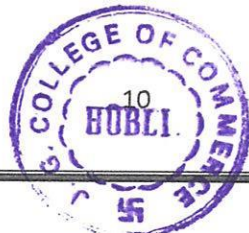

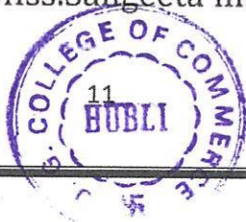
➤ **03rd December 2022- SVEEP –Voting Registration campaign**

➤ **24th December 2022-Natonal Consumers Rights Day**

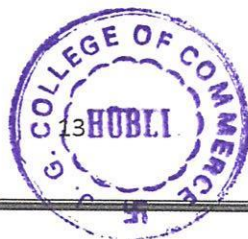

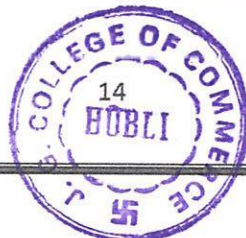
➤ **23rd January 2023 - Celebration of Subhashchandra Bose Jayanti**

➤ **14th February 2023- Candle March**

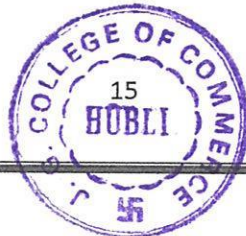

IIC ACTIVITES

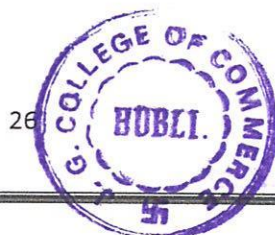

ACTIVITES OF DEPARTMENT OF POST-GRADUATES

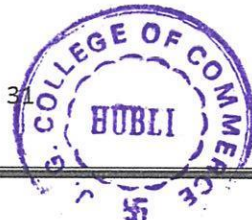
The academic year 2022-23 of PG department of studies in commerce is started from December 2022.
