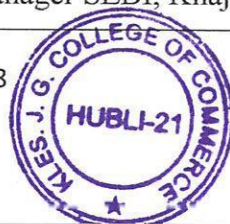

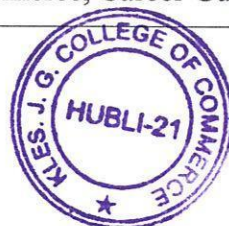

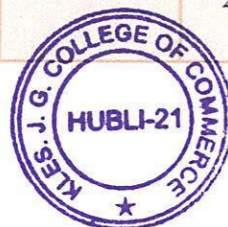

## CAREER GUIDANCE & PLACEMENT CELL ACTIVITIES

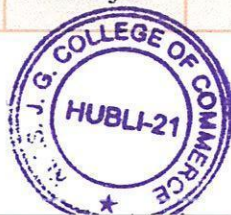

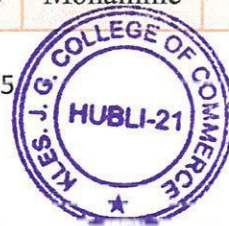

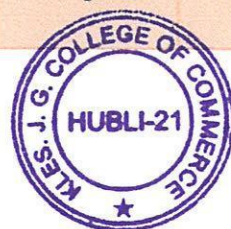
